Captain,

The below information should clarify the All Star Evaluation Process.

The Medford Softball All Star games are meant to be both an incentive to our league players exercising good sportsmanship as well as one way Parks and Recreation can give back to the softball community in which gives so much to Parks and Recreation. The All Star games are to be played June 13<sup>th</sup> – 14<sup>th</sup>, at the mid-season point for each of the leagues in the spring/summer season.

To be eligible for the All Star Team players must have shown good sportsmanship throughout the first five weeks of the season. The player, nor their team, shall have acted in poor sportsmanship. Poor sportsmanship includes, but is not limited to; taunting the other team, cussing at any point throughout the game, throwing of the bat following an at bat, excessively arguing with officials about a call or rule, conduct which results in disciplinary action. If a player, or the player's teams, is deemed to be a poor sportsman at any time through the first five weeks of the season, the player is no longer eligible to play on an All Star Team.

To submit yourself or a player of your choice, to play on an All Star team, fill out the Medford Softball All Star Ballot and turn it in to a member of the Parks and Recreation staff no later than May 27<sup>th</sup>, 2010.

The selection committee will be made up of a player representative, staff (officials, score keepers or facility supervisor) and a member of the Parks and Recreation administration staff. The selection committee will review all submittals and way them on two criteria; 1. Sportsmanship; 2. Skill.

The selection breakdown will consist of 24 players in each category. The categories are:
